Communities gain followers and likes, but lack the infrastructure to mobilize resources and drive real-world change.

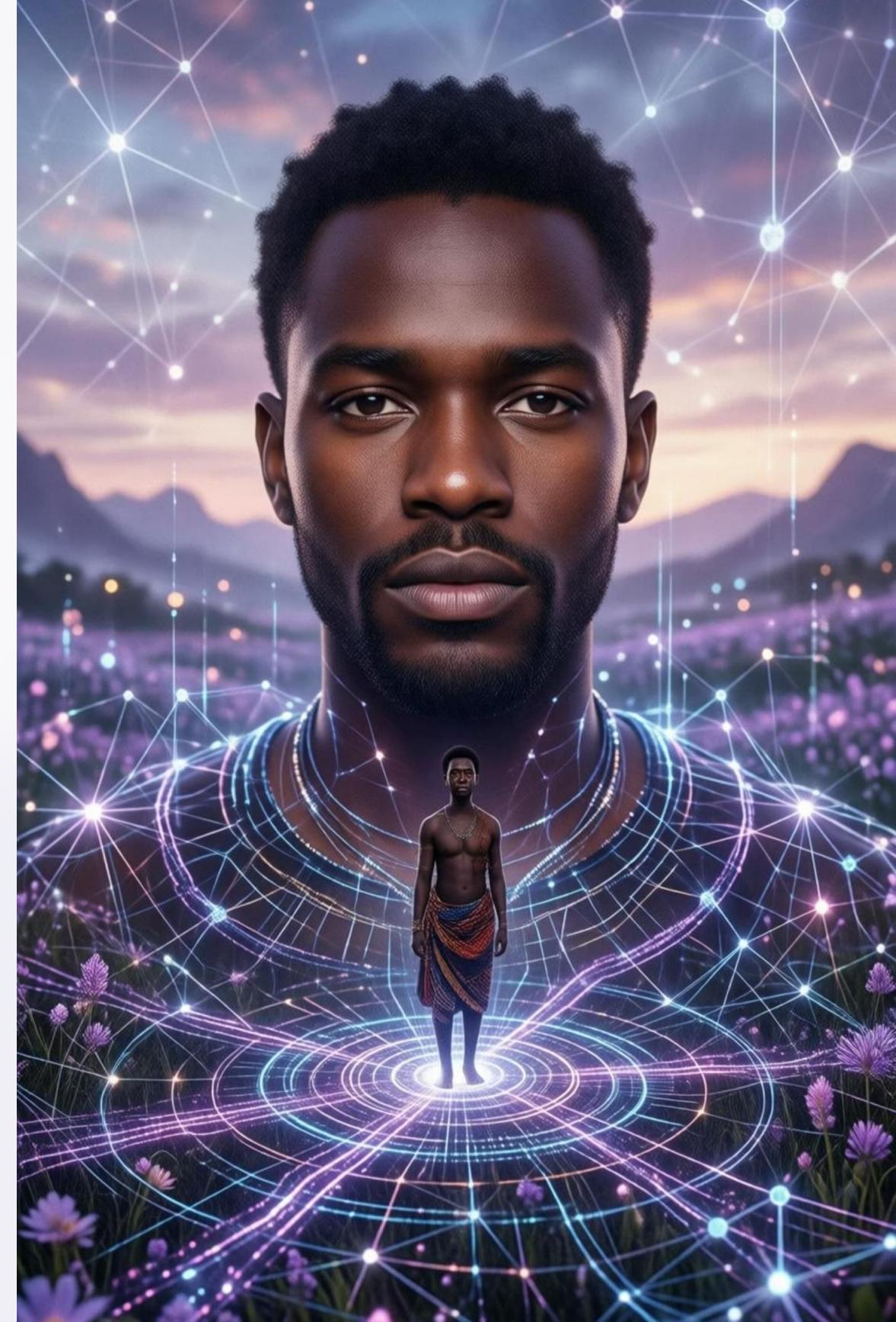

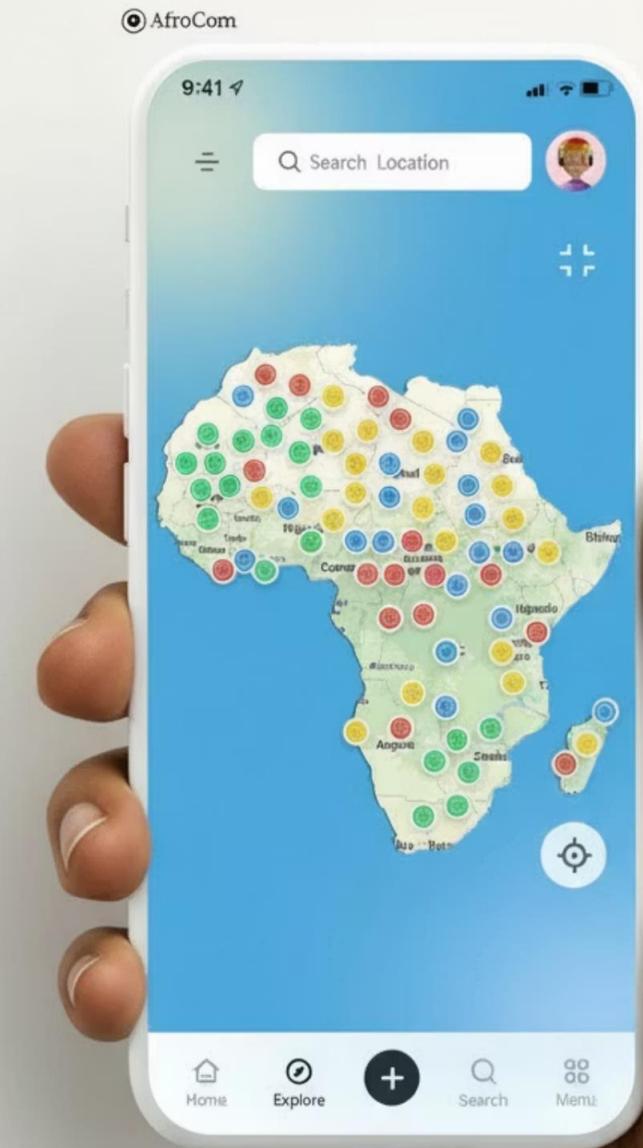
Projects & Initiatives First
